WHAT IS THE ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME KEY ACTION1?

Erasmus is a European Union programme that promotes cultural exchange.

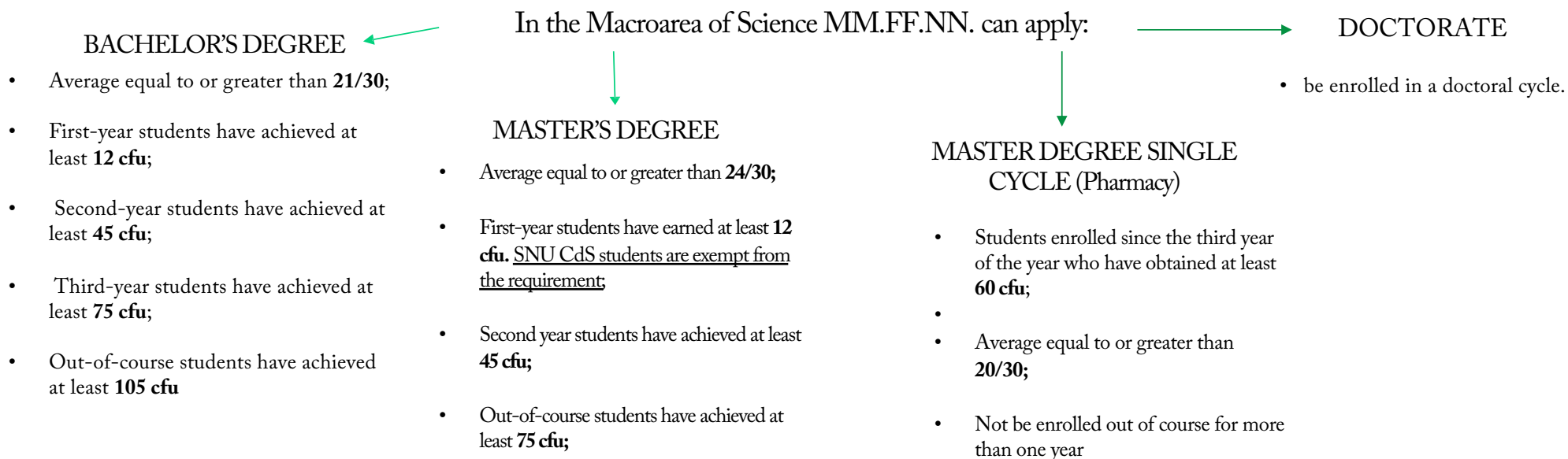
Erasmus+ Study

The Erasmus for study programme allows you to spend a period abroad, from 3 to 12 months, at one of the universities affiliated with the University of Rome Tor Vergata, in a country of the European Union or a non-European country, participating in the programme. The student will receive during his stay a financial contribution to support daily expenses, and will be exempt from institutional fees in the foreign university. Mobility is possible for each cycle of study, for attendance at courses and examinations, for the preparation of the thesis, for an internship, provided that it is accompanied by a period of study.



WHO CAN APPLY?

Erasmus+ students who are enrolled in a degree course, master's degree, single-cycle master's degree and doctorate program activated by the University of Rome Tor Vergata in A.A. 2025/2026, regardless of their country of citizenship, can apply for the Erasmus+ Call for Study, and meet the requirements of the Erasmus+ 2026/2027. Call for Proposals.





TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUBMISSION

- The application for participation must be submitted exclusively online at mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus/candidatura by **March 2, 2026**;
- Before completing the application, the student must verify that his personal data on Delphi are correct and up to date;
- For students enrolled in a master's degree course, their previous career will also be considered;
- For students enrolled in a master's degree program who have earned their degree from another university in Italy or abroad, it will be necessary to enter all the exams taken and upload the degree certificate showing their final grade, first enrollment date, exams, and teaching activities, along with their grades and credits;
- The duration of the grants corresponds to that established in bilateral agreements; however, the Erasmus 2026/2027 mobility must be completed by
- **30 September 2027**;
- If requested by the partner universities (available on the call), the student will have to upload a language certificate attesting to the level of linguistic knowledge required;



GRADING AND SELECTION

The selection (preparation of the ranking) is based on a score determined by the sum of two numbers that express the average of the grades and the evaluation of the credits with reference to grades and credits obtained during the course of study in which one enrolled at the time of the application.

In the case of students enrolled in the master's degree or doctoral research courses, **the evaluation will be awarded on the basis of their current and previous careers.**

In the case of students who have obtained a foreign qualification, **the evaluation will be carried out not only for qualifications obtained in foreign countries, but also through an additional interview**

IN THE CASE OF EQUAL SCORES:

Within the same course of study, in the event of a tie, candidates holding a certificate or linguistic attestation are ranked first.

In the event of a tie between students enrolled in a degree program and students enrolled in a master's degree program in the same area, they precede the students enrolled in the master's degree in the ranking.

In the event of a tie among students enrolled in a doctoral program, candidates with the best master's degree grade are ranked first.

Finally, in case of further parity of score, the youngest candidate is selected.



ALLOCATIONS

- ❖ Eligible students must attend the location assignment meeting, which will be announced on the Mobint website.
- ❖ The student must register at the host university (Application Form) and arrange the study project (Learning Agreement).
- ❖ The Learning Agreement will have to be approved by the Erasmus+ lecturer in charge of their CdS and completed on the mobint portal.
- ❖ It shall be the care of the winners to monitor the deadlines on the internet page of the host venue
- ❖ Changes to the study plan (Learning Agreement) are granted during the period of use of the grant (based on the period of mobility) by carrying out the same initiation procedure.
- ❖ Upon returning from mobility, all documents must be uploaded to the mobint portal to proceed with the recognition process.
- ❖ Recognition is made by the competent Council of CdS, based on the Transcript of Records certificate, and transmitted to the Student Secretariat, which will be responsible for entering the minutes of the approved documents.



- ❖ **After the mobility (recognition)** → It will be released by the host university Transcript of Records (ToR).

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For the choice of courses to follow in the host university, the student must refer to the teaching and to the Erasmus teacher reference of their degree program.

Therefore, the same shall:

- ❖ Consult the host site's programs
- ❖ Check the consistency of courses of interest with your own curriculum
- ❖ Check the academic calendar for course dates and courses
- ❖ Respect the registration conditions

If the student wishes to carry out a thesis project, please contact:

- ❖ Lecturer Speaker of his own course
- ❖ Erasmus Teacher Contact for your Course of Study
- ❖ Supervisor teacher at the host site



DURING THE MOBILITY

Upon arrival, the student must go to the Erasmus office of the host school and have the **Certificate of Arrival** signed in the ARRIVAL section which will be uploaded on mobint.

After arrival, the student can modify their Learning Agreement using the Mobint platform (**exceptional case**).

The student, **at least 15 days before the end of his mobility**, can request the extension of this activity to the Erasmus Macroarea Office which will ask for approval from the host location. You can only apply for an extension once and the **total period of stay must not exceed 12 months and must end on 30 September 2027**.

At the time of departure, the student will have to sign the same sheet of arrival in the DEPARTURE section, and obtain the **Transcript of Records**.

AFTER THE MOBILITY

Upon return from mobility, **within 15 days of the deadline and no later than 10 October 2026**, students must upload the following modules to the Mobint platform:

1. **Registration and stay confirmation form** signed and stamped by the host university;
2. **Self-certification module** exams/credits taken/obtained abroad;
3. **Transcript of Records**;
4. Completion of the "**Participant Report**" on the EACEA website sent by email.

MINIMUM ACQUISITION OF CREDITS

The European Commission requires that students participating in the Erasmus+ call have a minimum of credits acquired at the host university and will be recognized later by the university according to the Learning Agreement.

The student attending a **full year abroad** must earn at least **24 credits**; the student attending **one semester** must earn at least **12 credits**, while the student attending **one term abroad** must earn at least **6 credits**.

In the monthly fee/CFU calculation, the ratio **1 monthly fee = 2 CFU** will be taken into account.

If the required result is not achieved, the University may not proceed with the payment of the Community contribution and the supplementary contribution, or at least a part of them (it will be possible to assess special cases e.g. mobility for thesis).

Credits are not required for winners/recipients enrolled in the PhD.
